

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SHOP KEEPERS, STOREOWNERS,  
AND BUSINESS HOUSES LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF WALLIS,  
TEXAS, TO PROHIBIT SMOKING BY PATRONS IN SAID STORES,  
SHOPS, OR BUSINESS HOUSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS:

That the City Council in the public interest and to promote the general welfare of the citizens of Wallis, Texas, that any person or business entity that owns either in part or partial controls, operates, or manages a store, shop, or business or commerical house within the City of Wallis may prohibit smoking by all patrons entering such premises if clearly seen signs reads "NO SMOKING IN THIS BUILDING AS PER CITY ORDINANCE NO. 55, CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS", which must be prominently displayed in or on the business premises.

In the event of a violation of this ordinance, any person may file charges against the offender in the Municipal Court, Wallis, Texas and if found guilty of violating this ordinance, such offender may be charged with a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$200.00.


