## AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE CITY OF WALLIS

84

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Wallis, Texas, deems in the best public interest of the citizens of Wallis, Texas, that an organized and systematic management, control and procedurel plan be adopted to become effective in the event of natural disasters, war, riots and other major calamities occuring around and/or within the City of Wallis, Texas.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF WALLIS, TEXAS, that the Emergency Management Plan setout in full on the attached Exhibit "A" is hereby adopted and all of the directives and appointments established therein shall be made effective in accordance with provisions thereof.

This Ordinance shall be effective as of the date of passage.

If for any reason any section, paragraph, subdivision, work, phrase, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect any other section, paragraph, subdivision, word, phrase, clause or provision of this Ordinance for it is the definite intent of this City Commission that every section, paragraph, subdivision, word, phrase, clause or provision of this Ordinance be given full force and effect for its purpose.
