

PROHIBITING THE DUMPING OF GRAIN AND OTHER PRODUCE ON THE OPEN GROUND EXPOSED TO THE WEATHER AND FLOODS: PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT EXCEEDING \$100; PROVIDING FOR AN EXCEPTION.

WHEREAS, the dumping of grain and other produce on open ground, unprotected from rains and floods causes fermentation and decomposition, emiting offensive and obnoxious odors; and WHEREAS, the same attracts rodents and flies, creating a health hazzard; and

WHEREAS it is in the public interest and welfare to stop such practice; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WALLIS:

SECTION 1. Except as otherwise provided herein no person shall dump or store any grain or any other produce on the open ground exposed to rains or floods, within the incorporated limits of the City of Wallis.

Section 2. The provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall not apply where ear corn or other feed is stored in wire enclosed, #### floored and covered bins.

SECTION 3. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not exceeding \$loo and \$50 per day thereafter until material is removed and premises cleared
