

AMENDED ORDINANCE #63(A)

AN AMENDMENT TO THE CITY OF WALLIS ORDINANCE #63
CONCERNING REGULATING THE OPERATION OF RAILROADS AND TRAIN
WITHIN THE CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WALLIS, AUSTIN COUNTY, TEXAS:

All of said Ordinance #63 is left in tact and shall remain effective and unchanged as stated therein except for Section I, and said section is hereby deleted and hereafter non-effective and in lieu of said section the following substitute Section I is enacted and henceforth shall be effective and included as an integral part of the original ordinance #63 by and through this Amended Ordinance 63(A); and said section shall now be enacted and read as follows:

Section I: Speeds of trains through the City of Wallis shall be regulated and controled by the Federal Transportation Agency of the United States Government in accordance with the administrative rules, regulations and guidelines for trains through municipalities. Federal regulation of train speed shall remain effective until further order of any federal court of proper jurisdiction or superceeding congretional regulation.


