ORDINANCE NO. 188

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM LIMIT FOR THE APPROVAL AND/OR PAYMENT OF EXPENDITURES TO BE MADE BY THE MAYOR FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS

WHEREAS, Section 22.042(a) of the Texas Local Government Code states that a mayor of a type

A general law municipality is the chief executive officer of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, Section 22.042(a) of the Texas Local Government Code further states that the mayor shall perform the duties and exercise the powers proscribed by the governing body of the municipality; and,

WHEREAS, City Council wishes to establish certain powers and duties for the Mayor of Wallis,

Texas related to expenditures for and on behalf of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor may approve and/or pay expenditures for and on behalf of this city in any amount up to and including a maximum of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00).

Section 2. The Mayor shall also have the authority to sign contracts for which neither competitive bidding nor another procurement method is required by state law, as such laws may hereafter be amended for and on behalf of this city in any amount up to and including a maximum of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00).

Section 3. All expenditures above said maximum amount in expenditures or contracts require Council approval.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective after its approval and adoption by the City Council of the City of Wallis.

Section 5. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed; provided that such repeal shall be only to the extent of such inconsistency and in all other respects this ordinance shall be cumulative of other ordinances regulating and governing the subject matter covered by this ordinance.
