

ORDINANCE NO. 108

AN ORDINANCE SETTING A DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY BY THE CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO PUBLISH NOTICE OF SUCH PUBLIC HEARING; AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS:

On the 28<sup>TH</sup> day of JANUARY, A.D., 1988, at 6:30 o'clock p.m. in the City Hall of the City of Wallis, Texas, the City Council will hold a public hearing giving all interested persons the right to appear and be heard on the proposed annexation by the City of Wallis, Texas of the following described property, to-wit:

12.0968 acre tract of land in the Milburn and Davis League, Abstract 71, Austin County, Texas, being more particularly described in the Filed Notes attached hereto marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof for all intents and purposes; which said 12.0968 acre tract of land has been subdivided into a subdivision now known as HRANICKY SUBDIVISION, the map or plat of which is recorded in Plat Record 1, Pages 155-158, in Austin County, Texas, reference to which is herein made for all intents and purposes.

The Mayor of the City of Wallis is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice of such public hearing to be published in the Wallis News Review a newspaper having general circulation in the city and in the above described territory, during a period of time not more than twenty (20) days nor less than ten (10) days prior to the date of such public hearing, all in accordance with the Municipal Annexation Act (Chapter 160, Acts of the 58th Legislature, Regular Session, 1963; compiled as 970a, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes). The

importance of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the rule requiring ordinances to be read at three separate meetings be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
