

ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 28,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the matters and facts set out in the preamble of this ordinance are hereby affirmatively found and determined to be correct.

Section 2. That the incorporated City of Wallis, Texas, hereby accepts the provisions of Title 28 of the Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, 1925, as amended, by a two-thirds vote of its City Council at a regular meeting thereof, and a copy of this ordinance signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Secretary under the corporate seal shall be filed and recorded in the Office of the County Clerk of Austin County, Texas, wherein said City is situated.
