ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS

AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR PRO TEM ACTING FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS, TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE COUNTY OF AUSTIN, TEXAS, WHEREBY THE CITY OF WALLIS SHALL TAKE OVER THE OPERATION AND MANAGEMENT OF A CERTAIN AMBULANCE UNIT CALLED, ADAM UNIT 4, OWNED BY THE AUSTIN COUNTY EMERGENCY AMBULANCE SERVICE.

WHEREAS IT IS RESOLVED:

- 1. That there is a need for the City of Wallis to assume the operation, management and maintenance of a certain ambulance unit belonging to Austin County, Texas, under the aspects of the Austin County Emergency Ambulance Service.
- 2. That Austin County, Texas, has indicated a desire to turn such operation over to the City with the understanding that the City will cause such operation to continually serve the same areas as formerly designated to said Adam Unit 4, while under the sole control of Austin County Emergency Ambulance Service.
- 3. That as consideration for the City assuming such operation, the County agrees to reimburse the City in full for all expenses in connection therewith on a monthly basis.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WALLIS, AUSTIN COUNTY, TEXAS;

That the Mayor or Mayor Pro Tem is hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract (as proposed by the attached

copy, marked Exhibit "A" hereto), by and between the City of Wallis and the County of Austin, whereby the City will assume management of Adam Unit 4, a certain ambulance unit belonging to the Austin County Emergency Ambulance Service of Austin County, Texas, in accordance with all of the terms and conditions setout on the attached proposed contract, and no additions, changes or amendments to said contract are authorized except by a new and additional ordinance, presented and passed in due course according to law.
