This is a true and correct copy of the minutes of the Regular City Council Meeting for the City of Wallis, Texas held on Wednesday, June 17, 2026 at 6:00pm.

1. Call to Order

Mayor Parma called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

2. Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance

3. Roll Call and Certification of Quorum

A quorum was present. Present were Councilmember Jimmy Lavergne, Councilmember Belinda Halfin, Councilmember Joyce Parma, Councilmember Clark Main Jr., Councilmember David Marek and Mayor Parma.

5. Consent Agenda

Motion made by Councilmember Clark Main Jr., second by Councilmember David Marek to approve the minutes of the May 20, 2026 meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

7. Financial Review

Motion made by Councilmember Clark Main Jr., second by Councilmember Joyce Parma to approve the financial review and payment of bills. Motion passed unanimously.

- a. MIT-Grant Update – Construction end 5-25-26, Project end 6-30-26, Final invoices have been submitted. As-builts have been delivered to the city.

- c. 1093 Rails to Trails Update – Have a contract for salvage of rail to start the 22nd of June.
- d. TWDB Grant Updates, Wastewater Project – No updates at this time
- e. WSIG Grant, Water Supply Infrastructure Grant – This grant is a 100% grant. EDC was allowed to pay \$15,000 up front to Weishuhn Engineering to have the Project shovel ready to gain extra points. Weishuhn has finished drawings and they have been submitted to TCEQ. There will be an agreement with an explanation of the project brought to council at the next meeting between Weishuhn Engineering and the City for approval.

- b. Proposal from Chrissy McGee regarding Code Enforcement and Permit Inspections/Reviews.

Motion by Councilmember David Marek, second by Councilmember Joyce Parma to to continue with Chrissy McGee as Code Enforcer on an on-call basis. Motion was unclear to council due to this not being the proposal offered by Chrissy McGee Motion was recalled by Councilmember David Marek. Motion was made by Councilmember David Marek, second by Councilmember Belinda Halfin not to accept the offer proposed by Chrissy McGee as presented, which was to do” Code Enforcement, Health Inspections and all Permit Plan Reviews and Permit Inspections”. Motion passed with four (4) votes for and one vote against. Councilmember Joyce Parma voted against.

- c. Performance Agreement between City of Wallis and Wallis EDC

Motion by Councilmember Clark Main Jr., second by Councilmember Jimmy Lavergne to approve the Performance Agreement between City of Wallis and Wallis

EDC in regards to Wallis EDC paying Weishuhn Engineering \$15,000 in advance of application, on behalf of the city to complete shovel ready drawing to submit to TWBDB. Motion passed unanimously.

d. Engineering Contract Amendment 2

Motion by Councilmember Belinda Halfin, second by Councilmember Clark Main Jr. to approve Engineering Contract Amendment 2 for City of Wallis Sanitary Sewer and Stormwater Project CDBG-MIT 22-085-054-D311. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Councilmember Joyce Parma, second by Councilmember Belinda Halfin to approve Wallis Police Department Policy #3.18 – Academy Sponsorship and Repayment Agreement. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Councilmember David Marek, second by Councilmember Clark Main Jr., to approve Wallis Police Department to participate in the Federal 287 (g) Program. Motion passed unanimously.

g. Participation in the Internet Crimes Against Children Program (ICAC)

Motion by Councilmember Belinda Halfin, second by Councilmember Jimmy Lavergne. To approve Wallis Police Department to participate in the Internet Crimes Against Children Program known as ICAC. Motion passed unanimously.

h. Repair or Replacement of Walking Trail at Mynarik Park

Motion by Councilmember Clark Main Jr., second by Councilmember Jimmy Lavergne to approval of seeking out bids to repair/replace the walking trail at Mynarik Park. Motion passed unanimously.

j. Use of Tractor at Mynarik Park

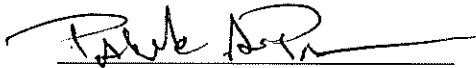

k. Future Agenda Items

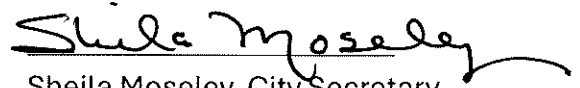
Charging Park for labor used at park.
