

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING THE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION FOR THE CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS, FOR THE YEAR 19⁸¹ PROVIDING FOR THEIR DUTIES AND COMPENSATION, AND TIME OF MEETING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the time has now arrived, for the work of the Board of Equalization to begin and no such Board has yet been appointed for the year 19⁸¹, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS:

That, August Zurek, Mary Lou Gomez, and James Rude1 are hereby appointed the Board of Equalization of the City of Wallis, Texas, for the year 19⁸¹, who are to perform the duties of such Board of Equalization for the City of Wallis, Texas, as prescribed by the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas, and ordinance of the City of Wallis, Texas; such Board shall receive all the assessment lists or books of the assessor of the city of Wallis, for examination, correction, equalization, appraisement, and approval for the City of Wallis, Texas; the members thereof shall receive for their compensation the sum of \$ 7.50 per day for each day they are actively engaged in such works; and such shall be convened on the 29th day of May, 19⁸¹. At each meeting of said board, the city secretary shall act as secretary therefor.

WHEREAS, the time has arrived for the commencing of the work of the Board of Equalization of the City of Wallis, Texas, and no such Board has been appointed, therefore, said rule is hereby suspended and said ordinance is placed on its first, second, third and final reading and shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage.
