

Ordinance Setting A Public Hearing On Contemplated Annexation

(Note: This public hearing must be held not more than twenty nor less than ten days prior to institution of an annexation proceeding.)

ORDINANCE NO. 177

AN ORDINANCE SETTING A DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY BY THE CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO PUBLIC NOTICE OF SUCH PUBLIC HEARING; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS:

Section 1. On the 28th day of December, 1982, at 7:00 p.m. o'clock in the City Council Chamber of the City Hall of the City of Wallis, Texas, the City Council will hold a public hearing giving all interested persons the right to appear and be heard on the proposed annexation by the City of Wallis, Texas, of the following described property, to-wit:

Two tracts of land described on the attached Exhibit.

Section 2. The Mayor of the City of Wallis is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice of such public hearing to be published once in a newspaper having general circulation in the city and in the above described territory not more than twenty days nor less than ten days prior to the date of such public hearing, all in accordance with the Municipal Annexation Act (Chapter 160, Acts of the 58th Legislature, Regular Session, 1963; compiled as 970a, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes.)

Section 3. The importance of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the rule requiring ordinances to be read at three several meetings be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
