

AN ORDINANCE ALTERING THE PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED FOR VEHICLES UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 6701D, VERNON'S TEXAS CIVIL STATUTES, UPON THE BASIS OF AN ENGINEERING AND TRAFFIC INVESTIGATION, UPON CERTAIN STREETS AND HIGHWAYS, OR PARTS THEREOF, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WALLIS, AS SET OUT IN THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY OF A FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$200 FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, Article 6701D, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes, provides that whenever the governing body of the City shall determine upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that any prima facie speed therein set forth is greater or less than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist at any intersection or other place or upon any part of a street or highway within the City, taking into consideration the width and condition of the pavement and other circumstances on such portion of said street or highway, as well as the usual traffic thereon, said governing body may determine and declare a reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit thereat or thereon by the passage of an ordinance, which shall be effective when appropriate signs giving notice thereof are erected at such intersection or other place or part of the street or highway, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WALLIS, TEXAS:

Section 1. Upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation heretofore made as authorized by the provisions of Article 6701D, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes, the following prima facie speed limits hereafter indicated for vehicles are hereby determined and declared to be reasonable and safe; and such speed limits are hereby fixed at the rate of speed indicated for vehicles traveling upon the named streets and highways, or parts thereof, described as follows:

- (a) Along SH 36 from the northwest city limits of Wallis to a point 690 feet southeast of the northwest city limits, a distance of approximately 0.137 mile, 55 MPH.
- (b) Along SH 36 from a point 690 feet southeast of the northwest city limits to a point 310 feet southeast of Legion Road, a distance of approximately 0.260 mile, 45 MPH.
- (c) Along SH 36 from a point 310 feet southeast of Legion Road to a point 250 feet southeast of 4th Street, a distance of approximately 0.480 mile, 35 MPH.
- (d) Along SH 36 from a point 300 feet northwest of Legion Road to a point 300 feet southeast of Legion Road, a distance of approximately 0.120 mile, a school speed zone, 35 MPH when so signed.
- (e) Along SH 36 from a point 250 feet southeast of 4th Street to the intersection of 9th Street, a distance of approximately 0.320 mile, 45 MPH.
- (f) Along SH 36 from the intersection of 9th Street to the southeast city limits of Wallis, a distance of approximately 0.388 mile, 55 MPH.

- (g) Along SH 60 from the intersection of SH 36 to a point 150 feet southwest of Legion Road, a distance of approximately 0.500 mile, 40 MPH.
- (h) Along SH 60 from a point 150 feet southwest of Legion Road to the southwest city limits of Wallis, a distance of approximately 0.291 mile, 50 MPH.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200).
