AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WALLIS, AUSTIN COUNTY, TEXAS, PROVIDING A SCHEDULE OF HOURS DURING WHICH BEER AND MIXED DRINKS MAY BE SOLD FOR ON PREMISES CONSUMPTION BY LICENSED ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN THE CITY.

WHEREAS, Wallis, Austin County, Texas, is a General Laws City, and is located within a county having a population of less than 300,000 inhabitants according to the last preceding federal census;

AND WHEREAS, there have been requests made by certain citizens for passage of an ordinance which will make it possible for business establishments licensed to sell beer and mixed drinks for on-premises consumption to sell beer and mixed drinks during hours more extended than is possible under the present circumstances;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF WALLIS, AUSTIN COUNTY, TEXAS:

That by virtue of the authority conferred upon the City Council by the provisions of Article 667-10, Sections a(1), a(2), and b(3), the following schedule of hours is hereby adopted, during which the sale of beer shall be prohibited in the aforesaid establishments:

On Sunday at any time between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon.

On any day except Sunday between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m.
